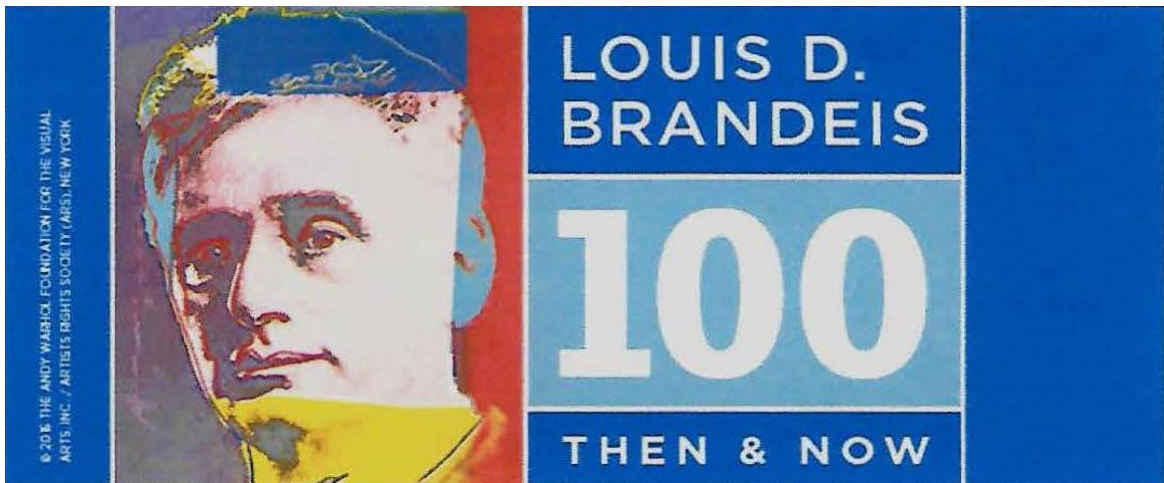

Brandies Campus News:

Commemorating the 100th anniversary of Louis D. Brandeis' appointment to the U.S. Supreme Court, Brandeis University will present an exciting series of events in the winter and spring of 2016 to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the nomination and confirmation of Louis D. Brandeis to the United States Supreme Court. The series will kick off on Thursday Jan. 28, 2016, on the 100th Anniversary to the day of President Woodrow Wilson's nomination of Brandeis to the Supreme Court, with a centennial celebration on the Brandeis University campus featuring remarks by Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg.

Following the initial event on Jan. 28th the university will host a series of discussions that highlight the thought and impact of Justice Brandeis and the continuing relevance of his ideas to the United States. There will be opportunities for campus groups to propose additional events and activities that tie in to the centennial celebration.

How many senses do humans really have? By Lawrence Goodman

Don Katz, an associate professor of psychology at Brandeis is rethinking what we thought we knew about the senses. Ask even the youngest schoolchild how many senses we have and she'll tell you five; sight, sound, smell, taste and touch. Neuroscientist Don Katz thinks this might be wrong. The correct answer, he says, will most likely turn out to be one. For nearly a decade, Katz, an associate professor of psychology has been investigating the interconnection of smell and taste in rats. In 2009, he showed that when rats lose their ability to taste, it alters their sense of smell. Two years later he published a paper suggesting that rats depend on smell as much as taste to determine what food they like.
