Leslie Milk is the Lifestyle Editor of *The Washingtonian*, where she has written about subjects ranging from caring for aging parents to Washington's most powerful women and from losing weight to gaining a son-in-law. Milk was recently featured in the March *AARP Bulletin*, writing about the challenges she faced as a new widow dealing with financial institutions that insisted on calling her by her husband's name. Milk's story on underage drinking in the suburbs won a gold medal for investigative journalism from the City and Regional Magazine Association. She has also been honored by the American Association of University Women and Capital Press Women. Milk received the S. Robert Cohen Award from the Jewish Foundation for Group Homes for her work for the organization and her advocacy for people with disabilities. Her daughter Meredith's wedding inspired the book, *It's Her Wedding But I'll Cry If I want To: A Survival Guide for the Mother of the Bride*. She is the mother of two theoretically-grown children, and the grandmother of four future Nobel Prize winners.
